'Rest of the World' beat 'England'

Finalists overcome 'India I' and 'Pakistan' in the semifinals

The Rest of the World won the 11th Orient Irrigation Services "International" Squash tournament played recently at the Dubai Country Club.

The Nikky Harradine Rest of the World beat England 16-4 in a closely fought final which went to the last of the five matches, with an utterly exhausted Phil Hancock just beating Peter Dale 2-0.

In the other matches, Steve Bennett defeated Sanjay 2-0 and Ash-

ley Durham got the better of Harradine (+4) 2-0.

However, Phil Deeb reversed an early loss to defeat Alan Lupton 2-0, and the unbeaten Roy Sequeira downed Ben Dale 2-0 to record wins for the Rest of the World.

The semifinals had seen the The Rest of the World playing India I, and it was a crucial point scored by Sequiera, whose draw 1-1 with fa-

vourite Robin Rodericks that enabled Rest of the World to win 6-4. Harradine also survived a scare - only just defeating Lena Fulcher (+10).

The other semifinal had seen England I beating Pakistan I 6-4. Ben Dale scored a crucial win here.

However, the turning point for England I was the injury to their captain Eddie Bishop, an injury that probably tipped their scales against them in the final.
